Narrative: HB 1318, if enacted, permits school districts, upon motion of the school board, to disallow a property tax exemption of the school district portion for new and expanding businesses. A survey of projects that received a property tax exemption showed that the school district portion of the tax was approximately \$1.21M for one year. With 4.5 percent growth in property taxes this would amount to \$2.70M in 1997-1999 and \$2.95M in 1999-2001 if all of the school districts passed motions to disallow the exemption and if all of the school districts could increase their levy that amount and still stay within the levy limitations.
