	HB 1420 would increase the fee received by the clerk of court , and retained by the county, for the filing, preparing, certifying, or issuing of certain miscellaneous documents. Relevant data is not readily available with which to estimate the fiscal impact of this increase. As amended, HB 1420 would require the clerk to collect a \$30 fee for marriage ceremonies performed by the clerk during regular courthouse hours. This fee would be retained by the county. A random survey conservatively indicates approximately 900 marriage ceremonies are performed in a given year by clerks of court during regular courthouse hours, thereby resulting in approximately \$27,000 in fee revenue per year or \$54,000 per biennium.
