ATTACHMENT TO REQUEST FOR FISCAL NOTE SENATE BILL NO. 2087

Under the arrangement in place at this time, there is no fiscal impact on either the Bond Bank or a borrowing political subdivision in connection with funding the required reserve amount for Bond Bank bonds issued to fund a loan. Any cost to the Bond Bank in connection with funding the required reserve amount with a letter of credit or similar instrument will likely be passed through to a borrowing political subdivision. The fiscal impact on the political subdivision will be determined by two factors - the largest dollar amount of the annual payments and the cost associated with the financial instrument providing the required reserve amount.
