	Effective July 1, 1997, NDCC Section 11-17-04 requires that an additional \$36 of each civil filing fee (excluding divorce filings) and all answer filing fees must be deposited in the state general fund. Currently, these fees are retained by the counties. SB 2268 would repeal the requirement for deposit in the state general fund. The fiscal impact is reduced projected general fund fee revenue of \$792,396 in general filing fees (based on 22,011 filings) and \$826,305 in answer fees (based on estimates cited during the 1995 legislative session) - for a total of \$1,618,701.
