Narrative: SB 2303, if enacted, delays reclassification of agricultural property in a developing area by allowing four conditions rather than three conditions to exist before a change in classification occurs. Because current law allows political subdivisions to levy an amount in dollars as has been levied in the highest of the previous three years, there will be no fiscal impact to political subdivisions. The one-mill levy for the state medical center may experience less revenue because of the delay of reclassification, however the impact will be less than minus \$5,000 per biennium.
