Narrative:

The bill would require the Department of Human Services to outsource the development and implementation of a program of compulsive gambling treatment services to qualifying service providers, and increase the appropriation for local gaming enforcement. The bill would fund these items by appropriating the amount, if any, of gaming and excise taxes and interest collected that exceed \$2,763,000 each quarter. This amount for each of 8 quarters in the 1997-99 biennium would equal a base line of \$22,104,000 of gaming revenue collections for the general fund.
