**BILL DESCRIPTION: Destruction of Workers' Compensation Claim Files** 

**BILL NO: SB 2334** 

**SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION:** The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, have reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

The proposed legislation would give authority to the Bureau to destroy files of claimants, who have been deceased for at least six years. The bureau may not destroy any claim file it specifically has been requested not to destroy.

SCAL IMPACT: Will serve to reduce off-site storage costs. Minimal impact anticipated.
