## SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION

BILL DESCRIPTION:

Presumption Clause - Physical exam requirements for full-time paid firefighters and

law enforcement officers

BILL NO: Engrossed SB 2343

**SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION:** The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, has reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

Proposed bill changes physical exam requirements for employers of full-time paid firefighters and law enforcement officers from the current annual requirement to once every 5 years for the first 20 years of employment or to age 45 and every 3 years thereafter.

FISCAL IMPACT: No impact. Will reduce administrative burden for employers of full-time paid firefighters and law enforcement officers.

**AMENDMENT:** In addition to the physical exam requirements outlined in the proposed bill, the proposed amendment requires medical evaluations every 5 years for 1 to 10 years of service, every 3 years for 11 to 20 years of service, and every year for those with 21 or more years of service as a full-time paid firefighter or law enforcement officer.

Amendment will result in no change to the impact for the bill as introduced.

AMENDMENT TO ENGROSSED BILL: Removes the conflicting physical exam requirements that were inadvertantly left in with the addition of the last amendment.
