- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-36 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the provisional certification of teachers.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Provisional teaching certificate - Period of validity.

- The education standards and practices board shall grant a provisional teaching certificate to an individual who holds a valid teaching license or certificate from another state, provided:
 - a. The individual submits to a background check as required of initial applicants in section 15-38-18.2;
 - b. The background check reveals nothing for which a North Dakota applicant would be denied initial certification; and
 - c. The individual submits a plan for meeting all requirements necessary to become a certificated teacher in this state.
- 2. A provisional certificate granted under this section is valid for two years and may be renewed, upon written request, for an additional period of two years.
- 3. Notwithstanding any other law, a provisional teaching certificate granted under this section is the equivalent of a teaching certificate granted under chapter 15-36.
