BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 54-27-25 of the 1999 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- Transfers to a community health trust fund to be administered by the state department of health. The state department of health may use funds as appropriated for community-based public health programs and other public health programs, including programs with emphasis on preventing or reducing tobacco usage in this state. Transfers to the community health trust fund under this subsection must equal ten percent of total annual transfers from the tobacco settlement trust fund. The state department of health shall make ten percent of the total annual transfers of the funds transferred from the tobacco settlement trust fund to the community health trust fund available to cities and counties on a dollar-for-dollar matching fund basis for city and county employee tobacco education and cessation programs.
- **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the community health trust fund, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$521,828, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to state department of health for the purpose of city and county employee tobacco education and cessation program matching grants, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003.
