- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 59-02-20 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the discharge of a trustee.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 59-02-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **59-02-20. Discharge of trustee.**
- 7 <u>1.</u> A trustee can be discharged from the trustee's trust only as follows:
- 8 4. a. By the extinction of the trust;
- 9 2. <u>b.</u> By the completion of the trustee's duties under the trust;
- 10 3. c. By such means as may be prescribed by the declaration of trust;
- 4. d. By the consent of the beneficiary, if the beneficiary has capacity to contract;
- 12 <u>5. e.</u> By the judgment of a competent tribunal, in a direct proceeding for that purpose, that the trustee is <del>of unsound mind mentally incompetent; or</del>
- 14 6. f. By the district court for failure to comply with section 30.1-34-02;
- g. By the district court for material conflict, animosity, or hostility between the
  trustee and beneficiary;
- h. By the district court upon criminal indictment or conviction for misappropriation
  of entrusted property by a fiduciary under section 12.1-23-07; or
- i. By the district court for any other justifiable reason.
- 2. A trustee may not be reimbursed from trust assets for attorney fees incurred for
  21 discharge proceedings pursuant to subdivision e, f, g, h, or i of subsection 1.
