- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for capital projects of various state departments
- 2 and institutions; to authorize the industrial commission to issue and sell bonds for capital
- 3 projects; to provide an appropriation; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5	SECTION 1. PROJECT AU	THORIZATIONS. The industrial con	nmission, acting as the	
6	North Dakota building authority, shall arrange for the funding of the projects authorized in this			
7	section, hereby declared to be in the public interest, through the issuance of evidences of			
8	indebtedness under chapter 54-17.2, during the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending			
9	June 30, 2001. The proceeds of the evidences of indebtedness and other available funds are			
10	hereby appropriated during the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, for			
11	the following projects:

1 The industrial commission shall issue evidences of indebtedness under this section with 2 the condition that lease rental payments need not begin until July 1, 2001. This authority of the 3 industrial commission to issue evidences of indebtedness ends June 30, 2001, but the industrial 4 commission may continue to exercise all other powers granted to it under chapter 54-17.2 and 5 this Act and to comply with any covenants entered into before that date. 6 The department of corrections and rehabilitation may obtain and utilize federal funds to 7 assist in the renovation of pine cottage at the youth correctional center. There is hereby 8 appropriated to the department of corrections and rehabilitation the sum of \$500,000, or so 9 much of the sum as may be necessary, from any federal or other funds that may become 10 available for this project for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001. 11 North Dakota state university may obtain and utilize federal funds to assist in the 12 construction of an animal research facility at North Dakota state university. There is hereby 13 appropriated to North Dakota state university the sum of \$1,860,460, or so much of the sum as 14 may be necessary, from any federal or other funds that may become available for this project 15 for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001. 16 North Dakota state college of science may utilize local funds to assist in the construction 17 of the electrical distribution system, steamline distribution system, and roof replacement project. 18 Available local funds are in addition to the state funds authorized in this section and will allow 19 further progress on the project. 20 Grand total special funds appropriation \$19,260,325 21 SECTION 2. BOND ISSUANCE REPAYMENT RESPONSIBILITY. Of the total amount 22 of evidences of indebtedness issued under the provisions of section 1 of this Act, a total of 23 \$4,347,040 must be available from nongeneral fund sources to assist in the retirement of the 24 evidences of indebtedness, issued for the project costs associated with construction of the 25 projects authorized by this Act: \$1,000,000 26 State department of health 27 **UND-Williston** 3,000,000 28 North Dakota state university project 347,040 29 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
