- 2 relating to the scope of school weapons policies.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-49-12 of the 1997 Supplement to the North
  Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **15-49-12. Definitions.** As used in section 15-49-13:
  - "Firearm" has the meaning given in 18 U.S.C. 921 [Pub. L. 90-351; 82 Stat. 197].
     Upon resolution of a school board, the term may also mean any weapon
     commonly referred to as a BB gun, pellet gun, air rifle, or CO<sub>2</sub> gun that will expel or
     is readily capable of expelling a projectile by the action of a spring, compressed
     air, or compressed gas.
    - "School property" includes all school land, buildings, structures, facilities, and school vehicles whether owned or leased by a school district, and the site of any school-sponsored event or activity. <u>The term does not include school trust lands</u> <u>managed by the board of university and school lands.</u>
