1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-06.1-06 and subdivision h of subsection 1 of

2 section 39-09-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to statutory fees for exceeding the

3 speed limit and to the speed limit on interstate highways.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7	39-06.1-06. Amount of statutory fees. The fees required for a noncriminal disposition
8	pursuant to either section 39-06.1-02 or 39-06.1-03 must be as follows:

9	1.	For a nonmoving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-08, a fee of any amount
10		not to exceed twenty dollars.

- For a moving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-09, a fee of twenty dollars,
