1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-47-15 of the North Dakota Century Code, or

2 in the alternative to amend and reenact section 15.1-09-34 of the North Dakota Century Code,

3 relating to school district bid requirements for used motor vehicles.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. If House Bill No. 1034 does not become effective, section
15-47-15 of the 1997 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and
reenacted as follows:

15-47-15. School contracts - Advertisement for bids - Publication - Exceptions -

- 9 Penalty.
- 101.Except as provided in this section, a school board may not enter into a contract11involving the expenditure of an aggregate amount greater than eight thousand12dollars unless the school board has given ten days' notice by at least one13publication in the official newspaper of the school district, received sealed bids, and14accepted the bid of the lowest responsible bidder who in the opinion of the school15board will best serve the interests of the school district. The provisions of this16section do not apply to contracts for:
- 17 <u>1. a.</u> Personal <u>Contracts for the personal</u> services of employees of the district.
- 18 2. b. School text Contracts for the purchase of school textbooks or reference
 19 books.
- 20 3. <u>c.</u> Articles <u>The purchase of articles</u> not sold on the open market.
- 21 4. <u>d.</u> Patented <u>The purchase of patented</u>, copyrighted, or exclusively sold devices
 22 or features required to match articles already in use.
- 23 5. e. Patented <u>The purchase of patented</u>, copyrighted, or exclusively sold articles
 24 so distinctive that only one brand can be purchased.
