1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-10-71 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to the penalty for fleeing a peace officer.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-10-71 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 39-10-71. Fleeing or attempting to elude a peace officer - Penalty. Any driver of a 7 motor vehicle who willfully fails or refuses to bring the vehicle to a stop, or who otherwise flees 8 or attempts to elude, in any manner, a pursuing police vehicle or peace officer, when given a 9 visual or audible signal to bring the vehicle to a stop, is guilty of a class A misdemeanor C 10 felony for a first or second offense and a class G A felony for a subsequent offense. A signal 11 complies with this section if the signal is perceptible to the driver and: 12 If given from a vehicle, the signal is given by hand, voice, emergency light, or siren, 1. 13 and the stopping vehicle is appropriately marked showing it to be an official police 14 vehicle; or

If not given from a vehicle, the signal is given by hand, voice, emergency light, or
siren, and the officer is in uniform and prominently displays the officer's badge of
