1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-17 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to injuring another while fleeing a peace officer; and to amend and

3 reenact section 39-10-71 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the penalty for fleeing a

4 peace officer.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 12.1-17 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 created and enacted as follows:

8 Assault or homicide while fleeing peace officer. A person is guilty of a class A

9 <u>felony if that person negligently causes the death of another or causes serious bodily injury to</u>
10 another while in violation of section 39-10-71.

11 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-10-71 of the North Dakota Century Code is 12 amended and reenacted as follows:

13 **39-10-71. Fleeing or attempting to elude a peace officer** <u>- Penalty</u>. Any driver of a 14 motor vehicle who willfully fails or refuses to bring the vehicle to a stop, or who otherwise flees 15 or attempts to elude, in any manner, a pursuing police vehicle or peace officer, when given a 16 visual or audible signal to bring the vehicle to a stop, is guilty of a class A misdemeanor <u>C</u> 17 <u>felony</u> for a first or second offense and a class  $\bigcirc$  <u>A</u> felony for a subsequent offense. A signal 18 complies with this section if the signal is perceptible to the driver and:

- If given from a vehicle, the signal is given by hand, voice, emergency light, or siren,
   and the stopping vehicle is appropriately marked showing it to be an official police
   vehicle; or
- 22 2. If not given from a vehicle, the signal is given by hand, voice, emergency light, or
  23 siren, and the officer is in uniform and prominently displays the officer's badge of
  24 office.
