## SENATE BILL NO. 2213 (Senators DeMers, W. Stenehjem, Watne) (Representatives Gulleson, Svedjan, Price)

AN ACT to amend and reenact paragraph 1 of subdivision e of subsection 2 of section 26.1-36-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to group insurance coverage for licensed professional clinical counselors providing outpatient mental health treatment.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Paragraph 1 of subdivision e of subsection 2 of section 26.1-36-09 of the 1997 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

e. (1) In the case of benefits provided for outpatient treatment, the benefits must be provided for a minimum of thirty hours for services covered under this section in any calendar year if the treatment services are provided within the scope of licensure by a nurse who holds advanced licensure with a scope of practice within mental health or if the diagnosis, evaluation, and treatment services are provided within the scope of licensure by a licensed physician, a licensed psychologist who is eligible for listing on the national register of health service providers in psychology, <u>a licensed professional clinical counselor who is qualified in the clinical mental health counseling specialty in this state</u>, or a licensed independent clinical social worker.
