1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-04 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to a mile tax in lieu of reciprocal registration; to provide a penalty; and to
3 provide an effective date.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 39-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 created and enacted as follows:

7 **Mile tax in lieu of reciprocal agreement - Penalty.** Any agreement, arrangement, or
8 declaration made by the director and involving reciprocal agreements dealing with highway
9 registration fees for the use of the highways of this state by trucks or truck-tractors from out of
10 state is void. However, an out-of-state truck or truck-tractor may use the highways of this state
11 if registered under the international registration plan or if a mile tax of fifty dollars per trip or five
12 hundred dollars per year is paid. The trip permit is valid for a seventy-two-hour period. A
13 person who willfully violates this section is guilty of an infraction for which a fine of five hundred
14 dollars must be imposed.

15 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act becomes effective on August 1, 2001.
