1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 63-01.1 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to the designation of industrial hemp as a noxious weed; and to amend

3 and reenact subsection 13 of section 4-09-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the

4 definition of noxious weed seeds.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 13 of section 4-09-01 of the 1997 Supplement 7 to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

8	13.	"No	xious weed seeds" means the seeds of either of the following classifications:
9		a.	"Prohibited noxious weed seeds" means the seeds of perennial weeds which
10			reproduce by seed or spread by underground roots, stems, and other
11			reproductive parts and which, when established, are highly destructive and
12			difficult to control by ordinary good cultural practice including the seeds of
13			leafy spurge (euphorbia esula 1.), field bindweed (convolvulus arvensis 1.),
14			Canada thistle (cirsium arvense 1.), perennial sow thistle (sonchus arvensis
15			1.), Russian knapweed (centaurea picris pall), absinth wormwood (artemisia
16			absinthim), hemp (cannabis sativa), musk thistle (carduus nutans), spotted
17			knapweed (centaurea maculosalam), and hoary cress (cardaria draba 1.).
18		b.	"Restricted noxious weed seeds" means the seeds of weeds which are highly
19			objectionable in fields, lawns, and gardens, but which can be controlled by
20			good cultural practices or other means, including the seeds of dodder
21			(cuscuta species), hedge bindweed (convolvulus sepium), wild oats (avena
22			fatua), and quackgrass (agropyron repens 1. beauv.).

24 created and enacted as follows:

- 1 Noxious weed lists Cannabis sativa. Neither the commissioner nor a county weed
- 2 board may include hemp, cannabis sativa having not more than three tenths of one percent
- 3 tetrahydracannibol, on the state list of noxious weeds or on any county list of noxious weeds.
