- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a Legislative Council study of the feasibility and desirability of
- 2 forming a multistate agricultural marketing commission.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. MULTISTATE AGRICULTURE MARKETING COMMISSION -

- 5 **LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY.** During the 1999-2000 interim, the Legislative Council shall
- 6 consider studying the feasibility and desirability of forming a multistate agricultural marketing
- 7 commission for the purpose of marketing agricultural products on behalf of agricultural
- 8 producers. If conducted, the study must examine which entities set and control the prices of
- 9 specific agricultural products, which federal trade policies assist or hinder the marketing of
- 10 agricultural commodities, which federal and state laws assist or hinder the marketing of
- 11 agricultural commodities, and which federal and state laws assist or hinder the use of
- 12 agricultural contracts. If conducted, the study must also examine how this state can work with
- 13 federal agencies and federal representatives to ensure the best possible climate for the
- 14 marketing of agricultural products on behalf of North Dakota producers. The Legislative
- 15 Council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to
- 16 implement the recommendations, to the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
