- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-21 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to interference with a telephone during emergency calls.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 12.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- Interference with telephone during emergency call. A person is guilty of an offense if that persons maliciously removes, damages, or obstructs any telephone line or any part or
 - if that persons maliciously removes, damages, or obstructs any telephone line or any part or apparatus on the line, or severs any wire connected to the line, so as to interfere with an
- 9 emergency telephone call. The offense is a class C felony if it was done intentionally. The
- 10 offense is a class A misdemeanor if it was done knowingly or recklessly.
