1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for the marketing of agricultural products.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$75,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of transportation for the purpose of developing a strategic plan to reduce costs of transporting North Dakota produced and processed commodities and products, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$250,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to North Dakota state university for the purpose of exploring a joint venture with the federal government to expand the mission of the northern great plains research center in Mandan to include value-added animal agricultural production and dryland agricultural production, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$20,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the agriculture commissioner for the purpose of developing and maintaining an internet marketing site for North Dakota products, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.
