- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-40.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the closure of schools in weather emergencies; to amend and reenact
- 3 section 15-47-33 of the North Dakota Century Code, or in the alternative to amend and reenact
- 4 section 15.1-06-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to length of the school year; and
- 5 to repeal section 15-40.1-09.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the closure of
- 6 schools due to emergencies.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 8 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-40.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 9 created and enacted as follows:
- 10 Weather or other emergency conditions Closure of schools Foundation aid. If
- 11 because of severe weather or other emergency conditions a school or school district remains
- 12 closed or provides less than a full day of instruction, the school or school district shall make
- 13 every effort to reschedule classes so that students receive at least one hundred seventy-three
- 14 <u>full days of instruction</u>. Any school or school district for which the rescheduling of classes
- would create undue hardship may request that, for purposes of foundation aid, the governor
- 16 waive the rescheduling in whole or in part. In requesting a waiver under this section, the school
- 17 or school district may aggregate hours during which classes were not provided, but the
- 18 governor may not grant a waiver for less than a full day of instruction.
- 19 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** If House Bill No. 1034 does not become effective, section
- 20 15-47-33 of the 1997 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and
- 21 reenacted as follows:
- 22 15-47-33. Length of elementary and secondary school year term.
- 1. All elementary and secondary schools in this state shall provide for a school term
- of at least one hundred eighty days apportioned as follows:

1		a.	One hundred seventy-three full days of instruction;
2		b.	Three holidays listed in subsections 2 through 10 of section 15-38-04.1
3			selected by the school board in consultation with district teachers;
4		C.	Two days for the attendance of teachers at the North Dakota education
5			association instructional conference; and
6		d.	Up to two full days during which parent-teacher conferences are held, or
7			which are deemed by the school board to be compensatory time for
8			parent-teacher conferences held outside normal school hours.

10		a.	Consists of at least five and one-half hours of instruction time for elementary
11			students; and
12		b.	Consists of at least six hours of instruction time for high school students.
13	<u>3.</u>	If be	ecause of weather a school must dismiss before completing a full day of
14		inst	ruction, the school is responsible for making up only those hours and portions
15		of a	n hour between the time of early dismissal and the conclusion of a full day of

19	and reenacted as follows:

21	1.	Dur	ing each school year, a school district shall provide for a school calendar of at
22		leas	st one hundred eighty days, apportioned as follows:
23		a.	One hundred seventy-three full days of instruction;
24		b.	Three holidays listed in subdivisions b through j of subsection 1 of section
25			15.1-06-02 and selected by the school board in consultation with district
26			teachers;
27		c.	Two days for the attendance of teachers at the North Dakota education
28			association instructional conference; and
29		d.	Up to two full days during which parent-teacher conferences are held or which
30			are deemed by the school board to be compensatory time for parent-teacher
31			conferences held outside regular school hours.
