7	The state board shall have all authority necessary to cooperate with the United States	
8	department	of education, or other department or agency of the United States of America in the
9	administrat	on of acts of Congress relating to vocational education, including the following
10	powers and	duties:
11	1.	To administer any legislation enacted by the legislative assembly of this state
12		pursuant to or in conformity with acts of Congress relating to vocational education.
13	2.	To administer the funds provided by the federal government and by this state for
14		the promotion of vocational education, and to contract with:
15		a. Any public or private institution or agency, board of trustees of any agricultura
16		and training school, or school district of this state; or
17		b. Any public or private institution or agency, or political subdivision, of another
18		state.
19	3.	To formulate plans for the promotion of vocational education in such subjects as
20		are an essential and integral part of the public school system of education in this
21		state.
22	4.	To provide for the preparation of teachers.
23	5.	To fix the compensation of such officers and assistants as may be necessary to
24		administer the federal acts and the provisions of this chapter relating to vocational
