4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 4-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Cleaning and conditioning of grain for propagation - License - Fee. A person may not clean and condition grain intended for propagation unless the person is licensed by the commissioner. To obtain a license, a person must file with the agriculture commissioner an application, on a form supplied by the commissioner, containing the information required by the commissioner. The commissioner shall establish by rule the fee for a license issued under this section. The commissioner shall issue a license on receipt of a completed application and the fee. A license issued under this section is valid for one year from the date of issuance. This section does not apply to a person who cleans or conditions grain for processing or

15 manufacturing purposes or for that person's own use.
