- 1 A concurrent resolution to create and enact a new section to article XI of the Constitution of
- 2 North Dakota, relating to authorizing the legislative assembly to provide that public moneys
- 3 may be paid over to an entity other than the state treasurer.

4 STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 5 This amendment would authorize the legislative assembly to provide that public moneys may
- 6 be paid over to an entity other than the state treasurer if the legislative assembly provides for
- 7 regular audits of funds and periodic reporting of the transactions.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF

REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

- That the following proposed new section to article XI of the Constitution of North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the primary election to be held in 2000, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota.
- **SECTION 1.** A new section to article XI of the Constitution of North Dakota is created and enacted as follows:
- Unless otherwise specifically provided by the legislative assembly, all public moneys must be paid over to the state treasurer as required by section 12 of article X. Whenever the legislative assembly provides that public moneys may be paid to an entity other than the state treasurer, the legislative assembly shall also provide for regular audits of the funds by the state
- 20 auditor and periodic reporting of transactions by the entity.
