1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council study the challenges facing the 2 delivery of health care in this state, including the concerns relating to reimbursement of 3 hospitals for medical services, technological innovation, and possible regionalization of 4 services. 5 WHEREAS, the delivery of health care is necessary for the health, safety, and welfare 6 of all residents of this state; and 7 WHEREAS, changing demographics indicate the average age of a rural resident of this 8 state is aging and the rural population is decreasing; and 9 WHEREAS, managed care is changing the manner of providing health care services in 10 rural portions of this state; and 11 WHEREAS, shifting populations may cause regionalization of provisions of hospital 12 services; and 13 WHEREAS, technological innovations such as telemedicine will affect the delivery of rural health care; and 14 15 WHEREAS, hospitals in this state are reimbursed for medical services by a variety of 16 sources, including individuals, private insurers, Medicaid, Medicare, Indian Health Services, 17 TRICARE, and Civilian Health and Medical Program of the Veterans Administration; and 18 WHEREAS, rural hospitals are facing financial hardship in part because of low 19 reimbursement rates for medical services; and 20 **WHEREAS**, changes in the Medicare reimbursement rate schedule, a benchmark for 21 health care insurers in setting reimbursement rate schedules, may negatively impact rural 22 hospital reimbursement rates for medical services; 23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 24 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
