- 1 A concurrent resolution for the amendment of section 11 of article IV of the Constitution of
- 2 North Dakota, relating to the filling of vacancies in the legislative assembly.

## 3 STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 4 This amendment would require the legislative assembly to provide by law a specific method for
- 5 filling vacancies in the legislative assembly to replace the requirement that the governor issues
- 6 writs of election to fill vacancies.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF

## REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

- 9 That the following proposed amendment to section 11 of article IV of the Constitution of
- 10 North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at
- 11 the primary election to be held in 2000, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the
- 12 Constitution of North Dakota.
- 13 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 11 of article IV of the Constitution of North
- 14 Dakota is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 15 Section 11. The governor shall issue writs of election legislative assembly shall
- 16 provide by law a procedure to fill such vacancies as may occur occurring in either house of the
- 17 legislative assembly. The procedure must provide that the district executive committee of the
- 18 political party of the member whose position becomes vacant select a person to fill the vacancy
- 19 until the next general election, at which time the office must be filled by election for the
- 20 remainder of the term. If the former member was elected as an independent candidate or if the
- 21 executive committee does not make an appointment within ten days after receiving the notice
- 22 of the vacancy from the secretary of state, the governor shall appoint a resident of the district to
- 23 serve until the next general election, at which time the office must be filled by election for the
- 24 remainder of the term.
