SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4042

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability 2 of developing and implementing statewide academic standards for and assessments of 3 elementary and high school students and a system of accountability at the school and school 4 district level. 5 WHEREAS, research has shown that a majority of American citizens support setting 6 and enforcing consistent academic standards that prompt students from all socioeconomic 7 backgrounds to achieve at higher levels; and 8 WHEREAS, states are using a myriad of strategies to develop and implement academic 9 standards; and 10 WHEREAS, to be effective academic standards must be accompanied by assessments 11 that measure students' progress toward attaining the standards; and 12 **WHEREAS**, the Superintendent of Public Instruction has developed various voluntary 13 academic standards, and a legislative study should be conducted before further development of 14 academic standards; 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE 16 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: 17 That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of developing and 18 implementing statewide academic standards for and assessments of elementary and high 19 school students and a system of accountability at the school and school district level; and 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and 21 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 22 the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
