1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the Indian affairs

2 commission.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 5 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in 6 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from other 7 income, to the Indian affairs commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 8 Indian affairs commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, as follows: 9 10 Salaries and wages \$273,507 11 Operating expenses 53,275 12 Equipment 2,300 13 Total all funds \$329,082 14 Less estimated income <u>19,575</u> 15 Total general fund appropriation \$309,507 16 SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - DIRECTORY FEES. It is the intent of the 17 fifty-sixth legislative assembly that the Indian affairs commission establish a fee to recover all or

18 a portion of its costs related to printing and distributing its directory.

19 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - INDIAN AFFAIRS COMMISSION FUND. It is 20 the intent of the fifty-sixth legislative assembly that the office of management and budget 21 change the name of fund 318 from the Indian affairs alcohol and drug abuse fund to the Indian 22 affairs commission fund and that the fund then be used to account for special fund revenues

and expenditures associated with the general operation of the commission.
