- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 27-09.1-05.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to selection of jurors from a judicial district in the event of a natural disaster.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 27-09.1-05.1 of the 1997 Supplement to the
 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 27-09.1-05.1. Selection of jurors from judicial district Impact of natural disaster -
- 7 **Grounds and method for selection.** The court, upon its own motion, may direct that
- 8 prospective jurors be selected from one or more counties in the judicial district in which the
- 9 court is located if the county of venue has a population of not more than ten thousand persons
- 10 and the court determines that the number of prospective jurors within the county of venue is
- 11 inadequate to obtain a fair and impartial jury. Following notification by the court, the clerk of
- 12 court of any county in the judicial district shall submit a specified number of names, with mailing
- 13 addresses, of the prospective, qualified jurors to the clerk of court of the county of venue. If a
- 14 natural disaster impairs the selection of a sufficient number of prospective jurors in any county,
- the supreme court, by emergency order, may authorize the court in the affected county to
- 16 obtain additional names and mailing addresses of prospective, qualified jurors from the clerk of
- 17 court of an adjoining county in the judicial district or from the clerk of court of another county in
- 18 the judicial district if a sufficient number of names and addresses is not available from the
- 19 adjoining county.
