- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 37-01-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the power of the governor to order out the national guard.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 37-01-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 37-01-04. Governor may order out national guard for public safety or in case of
- 7 insurrection or riot Reserve militia ordered out. In case of insurrection, invasion, tumult,
- 8 riot, or breach of the peace, or imminent danger thereof, a concern for the safety of the public,
- 9 the governor may order into the active service of this state any part of the national guard that he
- 10 the governor may deem proper. When the national guard of this state, or a part thereof, is
- 11 called forth under the Constitution of the United States and the laws of the United States, the
- 12 governor shall order out for service the remaining troops or such part thereof as may be
- 13 necessary. If the number of available troops is insufficient, the governor shall order out such
- 14 part of the reserve militia as he the governor may deem necessary.
