BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 4

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 23-07-17.1 of the 1997 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 1. No A child may not be admitted to any public, private, or parochial school, or day care center, child care facility, headstart program, or nursery school operating in North Dakota this state or be supervised through home-based instruction unless 10 such the child's parent or guardian presents to the institution authorities a 11 certification from a licensed physician or authorized representative of the state 12 department of health that such the child has received immunization against 13 diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, measles, rubella (German measles), mumps, and 14 poliomyelitis. In the case of a child receiving home-based instruction, the child's 15 parent or legal guardian shall file the certification with the superintendent of public 16 instruction public school district in which the child resides.
