## ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2182

(At the request of the Department of Human Services)

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new chapter to title 50 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to implementing a children's health insurance program.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new chapter to title 50 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 **Definitions.** As used in this chapter:
  - "Children's health insurance program" means a program to provide health assistance to low-income children funded through title XXI of the federal Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 1397aa, et seq.].
  - 2. "County agency" means the county social service board.
- 11 3. "Department" means the department of human services.
  - "Poverty line" means the official income poverty line as defined by the United
     States office of management and budget and revised annually in accordance with
     42 U.S.C. 9902(2), applicable to a family of the size involved.
- 15 **Duties of the department.** The department shall:
  - Prepare, submit, and implement a state plan for a children's health insurance program in this state;
  - Supervise the administration of the children's health insurance program throughout this state;
- 20 3. Take action, give directions, and adopt rules as may be necessary or desirable to carry out the provisions of this chapter, including:
  - Requiring no premium payment or asset test for eligibility;
- b. Setting an income eligibility limit of one hundred fifty percent of the poverty
  line;

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- c. Imposing copayment requirements for each pharmaceutical prescription and
   for each emergency room hospital visit; and
  - d. Imposing a deductible for each inpatient hospital visit;
  - Reimburse counties for expenses incurred in the administration of the children's health insurance program at rates based upon all counties' total administrative costs; and
    - 5. Administer all funds appropriated or made available to the department for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this chapter.

**Duties of county agency.** In the administration of the children's health insurance program, unless the department otherwise establishes eligibility, the county agency shall:

- Administer the children's health insurance program under the direction and supervision of the department; and
- 2. Make an investigation and record the circumstances of each applicant, obtaining information as may be required by the department.

Limitations of chapter. Health assistance provided under this chapter is not an entitlement. A person does not have a property interest in any health assistance sought or provided under this chapter. If the department estimates that available funds are insufficient to allow participation by additional applicants, the department may take any action appropriate to avoid commitment of funds in excess of available funds, including denying applications and establishing waiting lists, that is not forbidden by title XXI of the federal Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 1397aa, et seq.] or regulations adopted thereunder. If the department estimates that demand for health assistance is insufficient to draw down available federal funds, the department may take any action appropriate to maximize drawdown of federal funds, notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter.
