- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 16.1-10-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to electioneering on election day.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-10-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **16.1-10-06. Electioneering on election day Penalty.** Any person asking, soliciting,
- 7 or in any manner trying to induce or persuade, any voter on an election day to vote or refrain
- 8 from voting for any candidate or the candidates or ticket of any political party or organization, or
- 9 any measure submitted to the people, in any polling place or within one hundred feet
- 10 [30.48 meters] from any entrance leading into a polling place, is guilty of an infraction. The
- 11 display upon motor vehicles of adhesive signs which are not readily removable and which
- 12 promote the candidacy of any individual, any political party, or a vote upon any measure, and
- 13 political advertisements promoting the candidacy of any individual, political party, or a vote
- 14 upon any measure which are displayed on fixed permanent billboards, may not, however, be
- 15 deemed a violation of this section.
