- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 32-03.2-11 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to exemplary damages for accidents involving motor vehicle
- 3 operators under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 32-03.2-11 of the 1997 Supplement to the 6 North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows: 7 In a civil action involving a motor vehicle accident resulting in bodily injury, it is 8 sufficient for the trier of fact to consider an award of exemplary damages against 9 the driver under the motion procedures provided in subsection 1 if clear and 10 convincing evidence indicates that the accident was caused by a driver who, within 11 the five years immediately preceding the accident has been convicted for violation 12 of section 39-08-01 and who was operating or in physical control of a motor 13 vehicle: 14 With an alcohol concentration of at least ten one-hundredths of one percent 15 by weight; 16 Under the influence of a controlled substance unless a drug that 17 predominantly caused impairment was used only as directed or cautioned by 18 a practitioner who legally prescribed or dispensed the drug to the driver: 19 Under the influence of alcohol and refused to take a test required under C. 20 chapter 39-20; or 21 Under the influence of a volatile chemical as listed in section 12.1-31-06. 22 At the trial in an action in which the trier of fact will consider an award of exemplary 23 damages, evidence that the driver has been convicted of violating section

39-08-01 or an equivalent statute or ordinance is admissible into evidence.
