	 Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts. 							
Narrative: The Office of State Treasurer would require two additional FTE's, one attorney and one paralegal, to oversee debt collection efforts and supervise case—load assignments. This is in addition to the attorneys and paralegals in other agencies that are currently involved in debt collection. Operating expenses, office equipment and furniture, and office space would need to be provided and a computer—ized docket system. Additionally, the Office of Attorney General estimates the possible impact on that office because the bill provides for passing billable hours through billable agencies. The coordinating is already being achieved through the Attorney General's Office and the collections committee. This fiscal note only shows the impact on the State Treasurer's Office. 2.
