The educational cost per student was \$4,464 for the 1997-98 school year. The language does not specify what should be included in state support. This purposes of this note, state support is computed as the per student aid plus tuition apportionment minus the mill deduct per student. Education costs and taxable valuation were increased 2% each year and enrollments were decreased 1.5% each year in line with state estimates. Based on these assumptions, the per student payment rates would be established at \$2,335 and \$2,387 for the 1999-01 biennium and \$2,730 and \$2,790 for the 2001-03 biennium. At these payment levels, \$520.2 million and \$588.5 million would be required for the 1999-01 biennium and 2001-03 biennium, respectively.
