<u>Rep Monson:</u> Someone in the business for 20+ years is comfortable with experience and their private companies can ensure licensing requirements. To some extent we almost could remove the education for all agents but the newer agents don't have enough experience.

Laurie Wolf: (42.6) ND State Insurance Dept. Current has the Rule of 85. If an agents age and years of practice equal 85 then no continued education requirement should be needed. We would like to exempt major lines of insurance. This is very common in other states. There could be a
