Section 2 provides consistency in state law by removing the requirement of having a notary affidavit on the registration document of a foreign limited partnership, which notarization is not required on any other limited partnership document.

RE: HB 1139 - Related to Foreign Limited Partnerships

Representatives Dosch and Ruby introduced this bill at the request of the Secretary of State's office.

The main intent of this bill is to bring consistency and equity to these two sections of state law.

For the filling of a certified statement of amendment by a foreign limited partnership, Section 1 of this bill increases the filling fee from \$25 to \$40. The \$40 is the same amount currently provided for in state law and paid by a North Dakota limited partnership to file an amendment. Consequently, with the passage of this bill, the filling fee will be the same for both foreign and domestic limited partnerships. The additional revenue to the state's general fund will be less than \$500 during the biennium.

Section 2 of the bill provides consistency in the state's limited partnership laws by removing the requirement of having a notary affidavit on the registration document of a foreign limited partnership. Such a notary affidavit is not required on any other limited partnership documents. Therefore, as in Section 1, passage of this bill would apply the law uniformly for both foreign and domestic limited partnerships.
