A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 5 of section 4-05.1-19 and subsection 1 of section 4-05.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to state board of agricultural research and education biennial budget requests and use of agricultural research fund annual proceeds.

1A1492 VICE CHAIRMAN DENNIS JOHNSON: We will now open the hearing on HB 1181.

JERRY DOAN: Mr. Chairman and Representatives of the committee. I appreciate the opportunity to by here. My name is Jerry Doan; a farmer and rancher from Mckinzie.

The reason we are changing the language in this Bill is that the auditor said you should have some legal language in this Bill to make sure you are legal. I'm Chairman of the State Board of Higher Education. HB 1181, you have before you is sort of a house cleaning bill for the state board research and education. The first change there in section 1 that deletes the language that

The reason we are changing that is that it caused us a little bit of problems and I think that the S.B.H.E. would agree with that. We are actually out in front of the Governors recommendations. We are the first board to have to come Yet when we don't have any direction, so it caused us a lot of in and have to give a budget. extra work and the S.B.H.E. really is not in the budget cycle yet. They really were not prepared to be hearing our budget so then we ended up coming back again when they were more prepared so that they could actually ask questions for things that they needed and then we also had to go back once the Governors recommendation came out and rework our budget. We are just taking that language out. We will still go before the S.B.H.E. when they request it and do the same thing. It just get rid of that date. The second change is in section two there and where it is underlined they used the proceeds of the Agricultural Research Fund created for reasonable administrative expenses. As you know we have the gas tax research fund which takes the money from the refundable gas tax fund and put it in an Ag. research fund. We have been paying administrative costs but we had an audit this past year. mentioned previously. We need some language in there that will allow us to pay those administrative costs. We have a contract so that those costs can't go over \$50,000.00 a year. They have been coming in below that all the time. I don't want to belabor that but if you have questions, I'd like to answer them. There is nothing new. We simply have to make sure we are The other point is that I would like to offer an amendment. What this amendment will legal. do is right now the President of N.D.S.U. is on our board. That work fine other then he is a really busy man and this will allow the president or his designee. At the present time Keith

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Bjerke who most of you know will become the one that will attend our meetings and be a little bit more involved so this just allows a little bit of flexibility. That's the reason for the change. It make's legal. There are ten producers on the board and those ten votes basically set the direction of where we are going. Any questions. - The five persons appointed to the agricultural consultation board by the extension e. services' multicounty program units and serving in that capacity on July 1, 1997;

- The agriculture commissioner, who serves in an ex officio nonvoting capacity: g.
