# TESTIMONY BY JO ZSCHOMLER Director, Risk Management Division, OMB Judiciary Committee January 30, 2001

Mr. Chairman, and members of Judiciary Committee, my name is Jo Zschomler. I am the Director of the Risk Management Division of OMB. I appear today merely to provide information to the Committee. I neither support or oppose House Bill 1389.

The 1995 Legislature passed the Tort Claims Act that established the Risk Management Fund. Our Division administers the Fund to pay tort claims and costs associated with lawsuits filed against the State. We also provide liability coverage for the State Fleet. The Fleet owns 15 busses and shuttle busses. The bus passenger capacities are: 10, 14, 18, 21, 24, three at 25, two at 29, two at 35, a 36, and two at 45.

Currently under N.D.C.C. § 26.1-41-13(2)(c) the no fault insurer of a bus passenger is required to pay no-fault benefits. If a passenger in a State owned bus does not have basic no fault coverage, the Risk Management Fund would be responsible for paying those benefits. If HB 1389 is enacted, the Risk Management Fund would be the no fault insurer for all passengers. The Fund's actuary advises that if this Bill is enacted, a conservative estimate of the additional contributions required for the Fund for the 2001-2003 biennium will be \$150,000.00.
