The meeting was called to order. All committee members present. Hearing was opened on HB 1424 relating to licensing of contractors.

Representative Kim Koppelman, District 13, cosponsor. The intent is to update the reporting requirements as part of the license renewal process. Written testimony attached.

At Jaeger, Secretary of State. At first blush this law appears to have no value. We encourage the committee to pass the bill as is and not seek to eliminate it. We are comfortable with the change from ten to twenty five thousand dollars because of inflation. There are internal reasons for requiring this type of reporting: check term of compliance, type of license, requests for information from the public and the tax department. We are not ready to request the elimination of this section of the code.

Chairman Berg and Members of the House Industry, Business and Labor Committee, I am Rep. Klm Koppelman and I represent District 13, which consists essentially of West Fargo and a small surrounding rural area.

House Bill 1424 was introduced to modernize reporting requirements in statute for North Dakota Contractors.

Currently, as part of the license renewal process, contractors are required to report to the Secretary of State's office, any job completed over \$10,000 in value, during the prior year. The report must include whom the work was performed for, the customer's address, etc.

In preparing this bill, I visited with the Secretary of State about this practice and discovered that their office simply retains the information on file, but really has no practical use for it. It was noted that the Tax Commissioner's Office does occasionally use the information

Although some may question why we need to record this information at all, this bill doesn't seek to eliminate that requirement, but only to update the level at which it is required. The \$10,000 level was set in 1983. Obviously, a \$10,000 project in 1983 is quite different than a \$10,000 project today.

If adjusted for inflation and projected for 20 years, which would take us through the end of this biennium, this amount would be approximately \$25,000, in today's dollars. Accordingly, House Bill 1424 adjusts the reporting threshold to that level.
