Minutes: SB 2313 relates to the fee for driving without a muffler.

Senator Kelsh: (District 26; Supports) States that this bill raises violation fee to \$100 involving a commercial motor vehicle operating without a muffler. Currently the fee is \$20. Many truckers use a Jake brake and have no muffler and it's very noisy. \$20 isn't enough for the enforcement process.

Senator Espegard: Are you opposed to a Jake brake?

Senator Kelsh: No, just noise problems. \$100 might be too high, but \$ 20 is too low. I'm willing to find a compromise between the two.

Leroy Ernst: (ND Motor Carriers Association; Lobbyist #18; Opposes) States that there are laws in place that already take care of this. Another concern is the "commercial" (motor vehicle) part of the bill.

Senator Stenehjem: Here's what I see as the problem: Law enforcement isn't willing to pull these guys over for \$20. Is there a compromise you'd agree to?

Leroy Ernst: Yes, I feel "commercial" needs to be taken out of this.

Senator Kelsh: I would concur with taking "commercial" out of proposed bill and I'm willing to find a compromise between \$20 and \$100.

Hearing closed.

Senator O'Connell moves proposed amendment. Seconded by Senator Mutch. Roll call 1 taken 5-0-1. Senator O'Connell motions to Do Pass as Amended. Seconded by Senator Trepbeath. Roll Call 2 taken. 2-3-1. FAILED. Senator Mutch motions to Do Not Pass. Seconded by Senator Espegard, Roll call 3 taken. 4-1-1. Floor carrier is Senator Espegard.
