2. Negrative: Identify the aspects of the measure which cause fiscal impact and include any comments relevant to your analysis.

This bill calls for maintenance of a 2 mile spur of county road in Dickey County to be paid out of the Special Road Fund. The Special Road fund would pay the county approximately \$3,000 per year to maintain the road plus an additional \$12,000 every 5 - 6 years to gravel the road. As shown in 1B above, Dickey County would see an increase in their revenue by those amounts.

This bill would not change the revenues, expenditures, or appropriations for the state. It would reduce the amount of funds available for discretionary use by the Special Road Committee. The amount paid to Dickey County would no longer be available for use by the Special Road Committee in accordance with NDCC 24-02-37 which states that the Special Road fund may be used, within the limits of legislative appropriation, exclusively for the construction and maintenance of access roads to and roads within recreational, tourist, and historical areas as designated by the special road committee.
