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Minutes: Senator Watne opened the hearing on SB 2431: A BILL FOR AN ACT TO AMEND AND REENACT SECTION 54-12-05 OF THE NORTH DAKOTA CENTURY CODE, RELATING TO BIENNIAL REPORTS.

Sandi Tabor, Assistant Attorney General, testifies in support of the bill. 2431 is a house keeping bill. Auditors did no believe we weren't properly reporting our fiscal accounts. As our office expanded, information became harder to obtain for the auditors. We changed minor parts of the bill.

Senator Bereier, will there still be a large document?

Sandi Tabor, we have different reports we can run right now. I talked to county people and she told the auditor that we do that, the Auditor said, "not exactly."

Senator Nelson, if something were to come up, like the Tobacco lawsuit, would that be included.

Sandi Tabor, yes, anytime we have litigations we put them on records. As tobacco companies rewrite their companies by merging with one another or changing, it becomes harder for us to penalized them under current regulations.

During our last audit we were told we must provide a report with details as delineated in section 54-12-05. While we do provide a biennial report, it does not include the details required in the section. To do so our office would be required to make costly adjustments to our computer tracking programs. In addition the report required under the existing language would entail lengthy regurgitation of numbers with no analysis, and probably little real meaning. Consequently, we are suggesting revisions to the biennial report that will allow our office to provide a summary of information that we believe will have more meaning to those who read it. We respectfully request a do pass from the committee.
