

Minutes:

SENATOR FISCHER opened the hearing on SCR 4046.

SENATOR STEVE TOMAC, of District 31, introduced SCR 4046 as cosponsor. SCR 4046 IS A RESOLUTION TO STUDY ISSUES RELATING TO THE MISSOURI RIVER IN THIS STATE. He testified that this resolution is a biannual resolution to encourage the corps of engineers to fully implement the Pick Sloan program.

REPRESENTATIVE JOHN MAHONEY, cosponsor of the resolution testified in support of SCR 4046. He said the North Dakota did not get as much as planned of the Pick Sloan Project and did not benefit as much as some of the southern states. He stated it is important to take a long look at what was intended in the original Pick Sloan Project, where it has gone and what we need to do to further the proposes of it and the best interests of the state and the Missouri River.

JIM NAGEL, representing the North Dakota Guide and Outfitters Association and the North Dakota Sport Fishing Congress testified in support of SCR 4046. This might be a way to put

some "meat" in the study and have the Corps of Engineers listen to the upstream concerns that North Dakota is experiencing.

Written testimony of BILL PFEIFER of the North Dakota Chapter of the Wildlife Society was distributed to the Committee members. (See attached testimony).

There was no neutral or opposing testimony presented on SCR 4046.

SENATOR FISCHER closed the hearing on SCR 4046.

Discussion was held on SCR 4046.

SENATOR KELSH made a motion for a "DO PASS " of SCR 4046.

SENATOR EVERY second the motion.

Discussion was held as to the wording of the resolution and decided that maybe the Committee should "urge" instead of "direct" the Legislative Council for the study. This would seem to give the Council the options or choices of studies.

SENATOR FREBORG made a motion to amend the resolution to say "urge" instead of "direct" and the changes necessary to reflect that change further in the Resolution.



Chairman Rennerfeldt: I will open the hearing on SCR 4046.

Sen. Tomac: Committee this is a good resolution and I ask for your support. Each of the sponsors on this resolution are representing districts that adjoin the Missouri River. Each session we've sponsored a resolution similar to this to try and encourage the US Congress to fully adopt and implement the Pick-Sloan Project. There is one addition in this session and it starts on line 23 of page 1 where it speaks to the siltation of the Missouri River. This is in response to some recent work of Sen. Conrad and Sen. Daschle of SD have introduced into the US Senate. What it does is

create an awareness and reemphasizes the Pick-Sloan program. It is something we have done biannually and it is good to renew our commitment to this project.

Andy Mork - BOMMM: I have been around a long time. (talks about the steamboat interpretive center). We talk mostly about our bank erosion problem around the river. 3/4's of the needed protection is already in place along our 80 miles of river bank. In answer to the siltation problem of the Missouri River, anytime you have water carrying silt flowing into still water the silt settles out and you have a Delta. Since the damming of the river, the water table has gone up and they had to move whole towns. The silt is coming. We need to protect our riverbanks and buyouts are expensive. South Bismarek has many beautiful expensive homes out there. Hopefully this will help address the situation. This resolution is important.

Chairman Rennerfeldt: Any questions of the committee? Anyone else care to testify in favor of SCR 4046? Any opposition? If not I will close the hearing.

Rep. Solberg: I move a Do Pass.

Rep. Nottestad: I second.


