

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3050

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability
2 of realigning the divisions within the Department of Human Services.

3 **WHEREAS**, the budget for the department of human services is in excess of
4 \$1.3 billion; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the current organization of the department can be confusing and
6 intimidating for those in need of services, especially the elderly and the disabled; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the elderly, the disabled, and other clients of the Department of Human
8 Services would be better served if the department offered a "one-stop" access to services; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the realigning of divisions within the Department of Human Services may
10 lead to more effective and cost-efficient ways of providing services;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
12 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of realigning the
14 divisions within the Department of Human Services; and

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
17 the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly.
