SENATE BILL NO. 2103  
(Agriculture Committee)  
(At the request of the State Seed Department)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 4-09.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to elimination of administrative rulemaking proceedings in establishing fees for commodity grade inspections.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-09.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

**4-09.1-03. Grade inspection - Fees and charges.** The commissioner, with the approval of the seed commission, shall ~~fix by rule the~~ establish and charge fees for making commodity grade inspections, and the fees must be uniform throughout the state for periods of time as must be specified. The fee for commodity grade inspection must, as nearly as possible, approximate the cost of the service.
